ANTIQUÉ TRACTOR CLASSES: ALL 1957 AND OLDER

3500 – 3800 – 4300 – 4600 – 5000 – 5500 – 6000 – 6600

PULLING RULES:

1. RADAR SPEED LIMIT IS 3.8 MPH: AFTER 75' IF HORN GOES OFF YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THAT CLASS (INCLUDING PULLOFF).
2. OBVIOUS OR EXCESSIVE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ANF FOUL OR ABUSIVE LANGUAGE WILL BE GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION.
3. ANYONE UNDER 16 YRS OF AGE WILL LESS THAN TWO YEARS EXPERIENCE WIH OUR CLUB MUST RUN AN EMERGENCY KILL SWITCH. OFFICIAL DECISION IS OPTIONAL. TRCTOR MUST BE SHUT OFF BY OWNER IF TRACK OFFICIALS DECISION WARRANTS IT.
4. TRACTORS MUST BE OPERATED IN A SAFE MANNER AT ALL TIMES. SPEED MUST NOT EXCEED 4MPH ON OR OFF THE TRACK.
5. STAY FIRMLY SEATED AND BOTH HANDS WITHIN REACH OF THE STEERING WHEEL OR YOU WILL BE FLAGED. SEAT MUST BE STATIONARY.
6. TRACTORS SHALL BE STOPPED IF THE FRONT END RISES HIGHER THAN THE TRACK OFFICIAL DECIDES IS SAFE. WHEELIE BARS ARE MANDATORY. A FIRST-TIME PULLER CAN HAVE A ONE-TIME GRACE PULL WITHOUT THE WHEELIE BARS. HEY ARE RECOMMENDED TO BE INDEPENDENT OF THE HOOK POINT BRACKET.
7. TRACTORS MAY RESTART WITHIN THE FIRST 75 FEET DUE TO A MECHANICAL PROBLEM OR BEING IN THE WRONG GEAR.

TRACTOR RULES:

1. ALL TRACTORS MUST BE REGISTERED AT LEAST ONE-HALF HOUR PRIOR TO SCHEDULED STARTING TIME. LATECOMERS WILL BE SUBJECT TO A \$3.00 LATE FEE AT THE DISCRETION OF REGISTRATION OFFICIALS.
2. A PROTEST MAY BE MADE ONLY BY DRIVERS IN THAT CLASS, CLUB OFFICERS, THE FLAGMAN OR THE SLED OPERATOR BEFORE THE TRACTOR LEAVES THE TRACK.

3. LOCKED OR LIMITED SLIP DIFFERENTIALS ARE NOT PERMITTED.
4. DRAWBAR HEIGHT MAY NOT EXCEED 18 INCHES. HITCHING POINT CANNOT BE CLOSER TO THE TRACTOR THAN 18 INCHES FROM THE CENTER OF THE REAR AXLE. DRAWBAR SHOULD BE SIMILAR TO A FACTORY DRAWBAR. THE CLEVIN OR HOOK POINT MUST BE HORIZONTAL TO THE GROUND. DRAWBAR MUST BE SOLID IN ALL DIRECTIONS. PULLERS WITH A DRAWBAR OF CLEVIS PROBLEM WILL BE WARNED THE FIRST TIME AND DISQUALIFIED THE SECOND TIME.
5. ENGINE HIGH EDLE MUST NOT EXCEED THE MANUFACTURER'S SPECIFICATION AS SPECIFIED IN THE CLUB'S RPM CHART. RPM WILL BE CHECKED WHEN THE THROTTLE IS IN THE FULL OPEN POSITION. THROTTLES WILL BE OPENED BY THE OFFICIAL. ALL THROTTLES MUST HAVE A PERMANENT STOP. PULLERS USING TEMPORARY STOP (VISE GRIPS, ETC) WILL RECEIVE ONE WARNING TO ALLOW THEM TO INSTALL A FIXED STOP, BUT A SECOND OFFENSE WILL MEAN DISQUALIFICATION.
6. NO ALUMINUM MAY BE USED TO REDUCE THE WEIGHT OF THE TRACTOR. NO EXCESSIVE STRIPPING OF THE TRACTOR THAT TAKES AWAY FROM THE ORIGINAL LOOK OF THE TRACTOR IS PERMITTED.
7. ALL FANS, PTO OR EXPOSED MOVING PARTS MUST BE SHIELDED. SUBJECT TO BE CHECKED BY OFFICIAL
8. IF A TRACTOR WINS 3 FIRSTS IN ANY WEIGHT CLASS; THAT TRACTOR MUST MOVE TO A DIFFERENT WEIGHT CLASS.
9. THE ELIMINATOR CHAIN WILL BE 50 INCHES LONG ON DIRT AND 38 INCHES LONG ON BLACKTOP.
10. ANY PUMP FUEL IS ALLOWED. OCTANE BOOSTER IS ALLOWED. NITROMETHAN, NITROUS OXIDES, ALCOHOL AND LIKE FUELS ARE PROHIBITED.
11. REPLACEMENT BLOCK MUST BE STOCK APPEARING.

TIRE LIMITS:

1. THE MAXIMUM TIRE SIZE FOR CLASSES 3400 THROUGH 5000 IS 15.5 X 38 AND CLASSES 5500 THROUGH 6600 IS 18.4 X 38.
2. TRACTORS MUST BE WHEEL DRIVEN, NO CRAWLERS, DUAL WHEELS AND NO STEEL WHEELS PERMITTED. ABSOLUTELY NO RADIAL TIRES.
3. ANY CUT TIRES ALLOWED.
4. FRONT WHEEL RIM DIAMETER MAY NOT BE LESS THAN 12 INCHES.

WEIGHTS:

1. ALL TRACTORS MUST WEIGH IN BEFORE PULLING AND BE READY TO PULL.
2. FACTORY WEIGHT OR SOLID METAL WEIGHTS ARE THE ONLY WEIGHTS ALLOWED.

3. ANY PART OF THE TRACTOR OR WEIGHT LOST ONTO THE TRACK WHILE THE TRACTOR IS STILL HOOKED TO THE ELIMINATOR WILL BE GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION.
4. NO TRACOT MAY PULL WITH ONE WHEEL REMOVED TO MAKE THE WEIGHT CLASS.
5. THE FRONT WEIGHT OR WEIGHT BRACKET CANNOT EXTEND BEYOND ELEVEN FEET FROM THE CENTER OF THE REAR AXLE OF THE TRACTOR AND THE BACK WEIGHT OR WEIGHT BRACKET CANNOT EXTEND BEHIND THE REAR TIRE OF THE TRACTOR.

ENTRY FEES:

1. MEMBERS - \$8.00 PER HOOK
NON-MEMBERS - \$12.00 PER HOOK
FUN PULLS - \$5.00 PER HOOK
2. MEMBERSHIP DUES ARE \$15.00 PER YEAR.
3. PULL FOR FUN WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED IF YOU CAN'T QUALIFY FOR ANY CLASS PENDING AN OFFICIAL DECISION. TWO PULLS PER TRACTOR WILL BE ALLOWED. THESE TRACTORS MUST PULL LAST IN THE CLASS.
4. PAYBACK WILL BE 1ST \$20.00, 2ND \$12.00 AND 3RD \$8.00 WITH 3 OR MORE TRACTORS IN THE CLASS. WHEN THERRE ARE 2 TRACTORS PAYBACK WILL BE THAT OF 2ND AND 3RD PLACE MONIES. WHEN ONLY 1 TRACTOR, THE PAYBACK WILL BE THAT OF 2ND PLACE PRIZE MONEY.

RULE CHANGES:

1. IF A RULE PROBLEM ARISES DURING THE PULLING SEASN, IT CAN BE AMENDEED BY A SPECIAL MEETING TO BE ANNOUNCED TO THE PULLERS.

VOTING RIGHTS:

1. A MEMBER MUST HAVE PULLED WITH THIS CLUB AT LEAST ONCE DURING THE LAST YEAR TO OBTAIN VOTING RIGHTS.

ATTENDANCE:

1. THE CLUB RECOGNIZES ATTENDANCE EACH YEAR TO DESERVING ACTIVE MEMBERS. IN ORDER TO RECEIVE AN ATTENDANCE AWARD, MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL BUT ONE SCHEDULED PULLING EVENT PER SEASON.
2. ATTENDANCE IS CREDITED TO THE DRIVER, NOT THE TRACTOR.
3. FIRST PLACE WINS IN ANY CLASS ARE CREDITED TO THE TRACTOR, NOT THE DRIVER.

FARM STOCK CLASSES:

4000, 4500, 5000, 5500, 6000, 6500, 7500
EACH TRACTOR CAN HOOK NO MORE THAN 3 TIMES

1. NO YEAR LIMITS.
2. STOCK RPM.
3. STOCK DRAWBAR NO HIGHER THAN 18" – CLEVIN MUST BE HORIZONTAL TO THE GROUND.
4. HOLE IN DRAWBAR MUST BE A MINIMUM OF 14" FROM END OF PTO.
5. NO CUT TIRES / NO RADIALS.
6. LOW GEAR.
7. NO SHIFTING ALLOWED DURING PULL.
8. NO TURBOS, OR THE TURBO MUST BE DISCONNECTED.
9. LONGER CHAIN ON SLED.
10. ALL OTHER CATP RULES ARE APPLIED.
11. PAYBACK WILL BE 1ST \$20.00, 2ND \$12.00 AND 3RD \$8.00 WITH 3 OR MORE TRACTORS IN THE CLASS. WHEN THERE ARE 2 TRACTORS PAYBACK WILL BE THAT OF 2ND AND 3RD PLACE MONIES. WHEN ONLY 1 TRACTOR, THE PAYBACK WILL BE THAT OF 2ND PLACE PRIZE MONEY.
12. ENTRY FEE: \$8.00 FOR MEMBERS, \$12.00 FOR NON MEMBERS.
