**PULLING RULES**

1. Maximum of 4 (four) hooks per tractor.
2. Radar speed limit is 3.8 MPH: After 75' if the horn goes off you will be disqualified from that class (including pulloff)
3. Obvious or excessive consumption of alcoholic beverages and foul or abusive language will be grounds for disqualification.
4. Anyone less than 16 years of age with less than two years experience with our club must run an emergency kill switch. Official decision is optional. The owner must shut off tractor if the track official's decision warrants it.
5. Tractors must be operated in a safe manner at all times. Speed must not exceed 4MPH on or off the grounds.
6. Stay firmly seated and both hands within reach of the steering wheel or you will be flagged. Seat must be stationary.
7. Tractors shall be stopped if the front-end rises higher than the track official decides is safe. Wheelie bars are mandatory. A first-time puller can have a one-time grace pull without the wheelie bars. They are recommended to be independent of the hitch.
8. Tractors may restart within the first 75 feet due to mechanical problem or being in the wrong gear.

**TRACTOR RULES**



1. All tractors must be registered at least one-half hour prior to scheduled starting time. Latecomers will be subject to a \$3.00 late fee at the discretion of the registration officials.
2. A protest may be made only by drives in that class, club officers, the flagman, or the sled operator before the tractor leaves the track.
3. Locked or limited slip differentials are not permitted.
4. Drawbar height may not exceed 18 inches. Hitching point cannot be closer to the tractor than 18 inches from the center of the rear axel. Drawbar should be similar to a factory drawbar. The clevis or hook point must be horizontal to the ground. Drawbar must be solid in all directions. Pullers with a drawbar or clevis problem will be warned the first time and disqualification the second time.
5. Engine high idle must not exceed the manufacturers specification as specified in the club's RPM chart. RPM will be checked when the throttle is in the full open position. The official will open throttles. All throttles must have a permanent stop. Pullers using temporary stop (Vise grip Etc.) Will receive one warning to allow them to install a fixed stop, but a second offense will mean disqualification.
6. No aluminum may be used to reduce the weight of the tractor. No excessive stripping of the tractor that takes away from the original look of the tractor is permitted.
7. All fans, PTO or exposed moving parts must be shielded. Subject to be checked by official.
8. If tractor wins 3 firsts in any weight class, that tractor must move to a different weight class.
9. The eliminator chain will be 50 inches long on dirt and 38 inches long on blacktop.
10. Any pump fuel is allowed. Octane booster is allowed. Nitromethan, Nitrous Oxide, Alcohol and like fuels and prohibited.
11. Replacement block must be stock appearing.

**Tire Limits:**

1. The Maximum tire size for classes 3500 through 5000 is 15.5x38 and classes 5500 through 6600 are 18.4x38.
2. Tractors must be wheel driven, no crawlers, dual wheels and no steel wheels permitted. Absolutely no radial tires.
3. Any cut tires allowed.

4. Front wheel rim diameter may not be less than 12 inches.

### **Weights**

1. All tractors must weigh in before pulling and ready to pull.
2. Factory weight or solid metal weights are the only weights allowed.
3. Any part of the tractor or weight lost onto the track while the tractor is still hooked to the eliminator will be grounds for disqualification.
4. No tractor may pull with one wheel removed to make the weight of the class.
5. The front weight or weight bracket cannot extend beyond eleven feet from the center of the rear axle of the tractor and the back weight bracket cannot extend behind the rear tire of the tractor.

### **Entry Fees:**

1. Members- \$8.00 Per Hook  
Non-Members- \$12.00 Per Hook  
Fun Pulls- \$ 5.00 Per Hook
2. Membership dues are \$15.00 per year.
3. Pull for fun will only be allowed if you can't qualify for any class pending an official decision. Two pulls per tractor will be allowed. These tractors must pull last in the class.
4. Payback will be 1<sup>st</sup> \$20.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$12.00, and 3<sup>rd</sup> \$8.00 with 3 or more tractors in the class. When there are 2 tractors payback will be that of 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place monies. When only 1 tractor, the payback will be that of 2<sup>nd</sup> place prize money.

### **Rule Changes:**

1. If a rule problem arises during the pulling season, it can be amended by a special meeting to be announced to the pullers.

### **Voting Rights:**

1. A member must have pulled with this club at least once during the last year to obtain voting rights.

### **Attendance**

1. The club recognizes attendance each year to deserving active members. In order to receive an attendance award, Members are required to participate in all but one scheduled pulling event per season.

# FARM STOCK RULES FOR 2007

## Farm Stock Classes

**4000, 4500, 5000, 5500, 6000, 6500, 7000, 7500**

1. **Each tractor can hook no more than 4 times.**
2. Tractors can only pull ONCE in a class.
3. No year limits.
4. Stock RPM's
5. Stock drawbar no higher than 18"-clevis must be horizontal to ground.
6. **Hook point will be no less than 14" from PTO to hook point. Tractors without PTO will be no less than 34" from center of rear axle to hook point.**
7. Tire size limits will be: 4000-5500# 15.5 with factory rear rim diameter max. 6000# and above 18.4x38 max. Front rim diameter shall be 15 inches or larger. No cut or radial tires allowed.
8. Low gear only.
9. No shifting allowed during the pull.
10. No turbo or turbo must be disconnected.
11. Longer chain on sled.
12. All Other CATP rules apply.
13. Payback will be 1<sup>st</sup> \$20.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$12.00, and 3<sup>rd</sup> \$8.00 when there are 3 or more tractors in the class. When there are 2 tractors payback will be that of 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. When only 1 tractor in the class the payback will be that of 2<sup>nd</sup> place.
14. Entry fees are \$ 8.00 for members, \$ 12.00 for non-members.
