RULES FOR 2007 PULLING SEASON

ENTRY FEE

\$15.00 annual membership fee

\$10.00 member pulling fee

\$14.00 non-member pulling fee; also \$5.00 penalty fee can be charged to chronic late pullers.

Each tractor can hook twice, subject to change by board of directors and officers.

PULLER'S CODE OF CONDUCT

-SAFETY FIRST all tractors are to be operated in a safe manner at all times. No children are to be riding on the tractors.

-Excessive consumption of alcohol will be grounds for disqualification. 1st offense disqualified for 2 pulls. 2nd offense disqualified for balance of calendar year.

-Foul or abusive language will be grounds for disqualification.

-Anyone knowingly and obviously cheating will be banned from the club for 1 year. Final decisions to be made by the club members.

GENERAL RULES FOR ALL CLASSES

1. Drivers must be 14 years of age and drivers 14-17 must have written parental consent. The driver must be FIRMLY on the seat at all times. No bouncing permitted. The driver must have at least one hand on the steering wheel at all times, and no excessive leaning.
2. Pullers and track officials are the only ones allowed on the track. Track officials are to be paid members only. Track officials to flag tractors with front wheel 18" off the ground or what is not considered safe. No excessive weaving up the track.
3. Drivers must stop pulling upon the red flag or be disqualified. The puller takes distance where stopped, except within the 1st 75 feet, where he/she will be entitled to one restart.
4. Any tractor may be protested at any time by any contestant prior to the end of the next class. The protesting contestant will also be checked for the same infraction.
5. Tractors must be 1958 or older and/or tractors of series built in 1958. Serial number must be in proper place. Any tractor with wrong serial number will be disqualified.
6. Tractors must be registered before the 1st tractor in class pulls. Tractors must weigh in before hooking to eliminator.
7. Any weight or parts of tractor lost on the track while tractor is hooked to sled the tractor will be disqualified.
8. No dual exhaust unless the hood has factory access. No locked rear ends and no tractor is allowed to shift while pulling.
9. Tractors must be wheel driven, no crawlers, dual wheels, steel wheels or chains allowed. All fans, PTO's or exposed moving parts must be shielded.
10. Any fuel mixture will be grounds for disqualification. No conversion fuel kits allowed.
11. Any rule can be changed or added to, at the rules meeting or special rules meeting, called by the President or Board of Directors.
12. If at anytime any part of the tractor or sled goes out of the side boundaries, the pull distance will be measured at that point.
13. All classes are points. You must be a paid up-to-date member to accumulate points.
14. A member must have pulled with this club once during the last year to obtain voting rights. A family membership includes: husband, wife, children under 18 = 1 vote. Officers are able to vote.

DAIRYLAND PRO ANTIQUE RULES

CLASSES

3600LB, 3850LB, 4100LB, 4600LB, 5100LB,
5600LB, 6100LB, 6600LB, 7100LB

1. RPM's must be stock.
2. Drawbar max 20" high, stationary in all directions and hitching point cannot be closer than 18" from the center of rear axle to hooking point. The hole in clevis to be a minimum of 2 1/2" diameter and not more than 1" of stock material from hole.
3. Tire size in 3600-6100 lb. classes, Maximum tire size of 15.5x38. In 6600-7100 lb. classes, Maximum tire size of 18.4x38. Any cut tires are allowed. No radial tires allowed.
4. Front Weights Max 11 feet from center of rear axle to front most part of weight or bracket.
5. Wheelie Bars Mandatory. Max 10" off ground. Minimum of 22" wide with 5" pad to be behind rear tire and strong enough to hold weight of tractor. Bars not to be hooked to pulling drawbar. We highly recommend engine side shields.
6. Pressed steel allowed in all classes. Row crop tractors fenders are optional.
7. Chain on eliminator to be 52" long inside of hook.
8. Radar speed limit is 3.7 MPH; after 75' if horn goes off you will be disqualified.
9. Open classes - tractors can pull any gear with stock RPM's.
10. No deck plates, shims, or girdles.
11. Tractors must have stock appearing block and No V-8, transmission, rear end and axle housings or manufacturer replacement.
12. Aluminum covers, weight brackets, wheelie bars and fuel tanks, and wheels are ok.

DAIRYLAND FARM STOCK RULES

CLASSES

4100 LB, 4600 LB, 5100 LB, 5600 LB,
6100 LB, 6600 LB, 7100 LB

1. Tractors must have stock block and use replacement parts
2. No performance pulling parts, no modified stroker crankshafts, no welded pistons, modified rocker arms, cut and welded connecting rods.
3. RPM's must be stock
4. No stripping of tractors.
5. **Drawbar-Max** 16" high measured at hooking point of clevis and 14" from end of 540 PTO to hole in drawbar. Owner to furnish twisted clevis 2 1/2" diameter hole. No quick adjusting drawbars. Drawbars to maintain original appearance. All Farmall M & Super M's must be 35" from center of rear axle to center of drawbar hole.
6. Tractors to have O.E.M Wheels.
Maximum tire size for classes 4100lb, 4600lb, 5100lb, 13.6 x 38 14.9 x 28 or equivalent
Maximum tire size for classes 5600lb, 6100lb, 6600lb, 7100lb, 15.5 x 38 16.9 x 28 or equivalent
7. No cutting or altering of tires, No radial tires.
8. Weight Brackets are allowed. Front weights-24" max. From end of the weight to center of front axle. Rear weights must not hang past back tire
9. Tractor to pull in low gear only. TA tractors not allowed to shift during pull.
10. John Deere Tractors that have creeper gear have option of 2nd gear.
11. Tractors must use 93 octane or less, LP gas or diesel fuel.
12. Stock carburetor for make and model attached to stock air cleaner
13. Distributors can be used on antiques. No square coils, MSD boxes or chrome coils allowed.
14. 1st Place has option of trophy or First place money with money payback for 2nd and 3rd.
