GENERAL RULES:

- Contestants must be 18 years of age or 16 & 17 years old MUST have prior written permission to do so.
 - Tractors may pull in a maximum of three weight classes.
 - Classes may change at judge's discretion.
 - Throttles must have Positive Stop.
 - No front cut tires.
 - Drawbar height not to exceed 20 inches, or closer than 18 inches, from center of rear axle. Anchor point of drawbar must be in stock location.
 - Drawbar must be stationary in all directions.
 - No 4-wheel drive, dual or crawler-type tractors.
 - Front weights not to exceed 24 inches beyond front of tractor.
 - Rear weights not to exceed 24 inches behind rear axle.
 - Weights cannot interfere with hook up. Weights must be securely fastened and must have 12" Clearance span above drawbar.
 - Anything that falls off before tractor is unhooked from sled will cause persons to be disqualified.
 - Any tractor violating the boundary of track will be measured at that point.
 - Driver must remain in the seat with one hand on the steering wheel at all times.
 - Drawbar must be equipped with clevis or 3 inch pulling eye.
 - All exhausts must discharge upward. No raincaps.
 - All tractors shall be out of gear for hooking and unhooking.
 - First pull will have option to take 1st pull or drop back to last position.
 - Drivers will be allowed two starts if stopped before the 75 feet mark.
 - The pull will start with a tight hook-up!! NO JERK!!!
 - Tractors must have original or original replacement block and drivetrain of each manufactured tractor.
 - Tractor MUST be operated in safe manner at all times; speed must not exceed 3 mph off track.
 - Any tractor found to be unsafe may be disqualified before, during or after the pull.
 - No refund of entry fees due to tractor disqualification.
 - Classes are NOT going to run in order!
 - All decisions by the judges are final.
- NO CRY BABIES!

Farm Stock Only:

1. Tractor must have O.E.M (or current replacement) engine, frame, drive train, and original front grill, radiator, fuel tank, hood, rockshaft housing, seat support, fenders and working PTO.
2. RPM Limited to 2800.
3. No fiberglass or lightweight components.
4. TO-4 or smaller chargers.
5. Must be Stock with workable governors and stock wheels and tires.
6. Stock Intercoolers Only.
7. No P-style pumps.
8. No Water Injection or Waste Gates
9. Use of Performance Enhancing Equipment or Fuels will result in Disqualification of Tractor.
10. 2.6 Inlet on Turbo - Will be checked

Altered Farm:

1. NIPA Rules, only 1 fuel.
2. 3 x 3 or smaller chargers.
3. 20" Drawbar Height.
4. RPM Limit of 2800 without safety equipment.
5. Safety equipment required: wheelie bars, kill switch, blast blanket or min 1/4" steel plate, steel flywheel & engine shields.
6. No Waste Gates
