2. Tractors may enter up to 2 classes (except as noted*may not cross enter).
3. Classes are as follows:

A. Antique #3,500

B. Antique #4,500

C. Antique #5,500

D. Antique #6,000 *Pure Stock

E. Antique #6,000 *Open

F. Farm #6,000

G. Antique #6,500

H. Farm #8,000

I. Antique #8,500

J. Farm #10,000

K. Farm #12,000

L. Farm #14,500 -*2800rpm

M. Farm #17,000

N. 4 Wheel Drive – prorated weight - 4' per #1,000

4. Entry Fee \$15 per class.
5. 18-inch hitch height in classes A-J.
6. 20-inch hitch height in classes K-M.
7. 21-inch hitch height in class N.
8. Stock RPM's in all classes excluding the #6,000 Antique Open (safety blankets required) & #14,500 Farm may pull at 2,800 RPM's.
9. Add on turbos are permitted, however, you must pull in the next heavier weight if you use one, for example, #8000 tractor with an add on turbo must pull in the #10000 class.
10. No 2WD tractors are permitted in the 4WD class – prorated weights – example: if opponent weighs #20000 and you weigh #21000, you must pull 4 feet 1 inch farther to win.
11. Horsepower limit in the farm classes goes by weight, for example #8,000-80 horse max, #12,000-120 horse max, etc.
12. Coordinators are not responsible for lost, stolen, damaged items or property.
13. Understand tractor pulling can be dangerous, you are pulling at your own risk and if you have children along please watch them so they stay out of harms way.
