## General Rules for all Pullers

1. **Safety First. Always think safety, Always act safely. Drive slowly, look around and think of others.**
2. **All contestants enter at their own risk.**
3. Order of pull with in each class will be determined by lottery drawing at registration. All tractors must post pull number on side of tractor.
4. Drivers must be age 14. Age 14-18 years must have written permission from parents or guardians to inter tractor pull and present a farm safety course certification. Drivers must be 18 to drive in open or unpaced classes.
5. Driver must remain in seat at all times, and operate the tractor in a safe manner at all times on and off the track.
6. Kill switches, wheelie bars, and fenders are recommended but not mandatory except in unpaced classes. Wheelie bars must be strong enough to hold tractor when tested. If no wheelie bars, the tractor will be flagged to stop when the front wheels exceed knee high above the ground.
7. All tires must be on the tractor, No tracks allowed.
8. All tractors will be weighed, and drawbar checked as you line up for your class, any tractor can be reweighed after pull by promoters request.
9. **The pull will start with a tight hook-up, NO JERKING**
10. If anything falls off the tractor before it is unhooked from the eliminator, the tractor is disqualified.
11. The officials have the right to stop any entry at any time during the pull. Pay attention to officials, there word is final.
12. Any tractor violating track boundary will be measured from that point if they stop promptly, or else will be DQ'd.
13. **Drawbar height not to exceed 20" for all classes, except stock antique which will be 18". Drawbar must be at least 18" back of center of rear axle. Drawbar must be rigid in all directions, (NO FLOATING DRAWBARS) Tractors must be equipped with a 21/2 clevis or pulling eye. Height will be checked on scale.**
14. Only one pull per wight class per tractor, unless of a tie requiring a pull off.
15. **No alcohol may be consumed by drivers before or during pulling a tractor.**
16. **All driver are to be in line and ready to pull at the start of their weight class.**
17. No registrations after start of each respective class.
18. *Official decisions made at drivers meeting take priority over printed rules.*
19. Paced classes will be paced with a speedometer on sled and a horn sounding when speeding, after 100 ft. cone any horn blowing will result in a DQ.
20. **No Massey 44, Oliver 88, M-M U, and UB shall enter any class below 4600.**
21. **HAVE FUN, THATS WHAT WE ARE ALL HERE FOR!!!!**

### **Additional Rules for Stock Classes**

1. Age; Tractor must be 1957 or older.
2. **HP & RPM; NO more than 10% over on HP or RPM's allowed according to the Nebraska Test.** Working PTO, unaltered positive throttle stop, and working governor are mandatory. RPM's will be checked if in question, and HP will be checked if dyno is available.
3. **Tires; 15.5 up to 5000 lbs, 16.9 in classes over 5000. No cuts of any kind.**
4. Tractor must have stock block, carburetor, and serial number attached for make and model.
5. Tractor will run on stock fuel only.
6. **Speed; low gear only, not to exceed 3 mph.**
7. Weights; must be secured safely, and securely to tractor. No weights in front of front casting, nor beyond rear tires.
8. **Drawbar Height will be 18", and no closer than 24" from center of axle.**

### **Additional Rules for Antique Classes**

1. **Age;** Tractors must be 1955 or older.
2. HP & RPM'S; Any horsepower is allowed.
3. Tires; Maximum rear tire size is 16.9 x 38 up to 4750. 18.4 x 38 in all classes above 4750.
4. **Weights;** Weights may not extend more than 24" in front of tractor casting and rearward no more than the rear edge of the tires. They will also be securely fastened.
5. **Drawbar Height - 20" in all classes, (rigid in all directions).**
6. Tractors must have stock block for the make and model. No alcohol fuel, no nitrous gas, or ether is allowed. Officials have the right to test and inspect fuel.
7. **Pace; The pace is 4 MPH, you will have 100' to set your speed, after the cone if the horn blows you will be DQ'd.**

### **Additional Rules for Unpaced Antique Classes**

1. **Age;** Tractors must be 1955 or older.
2. **Any HP is allowed,** If RPM's exceed twice the factory specs, then safety equipment should be used.
3. Tires; Maximum rear tire size if 16.9" x 38" up to 4750, and 18.4" x 38" in all classes above 4750.
4. Weights; Can not extend more than 24" in front of casting, or rearward outside of the rear tires.
5. **Drawbar Height; 20" for all classes, (rigid in all directions).**
6. Tractor will have stock block for the make and model. No alcohol, nitrous, or ether allowed, or any other power enhancing fuels. Officials can and will test fuel if in question..

### **Additional Rules for Farm Classes**

1. Age; Tractors can be any age. All drivers must be 18 years of age or older to pull in Farm classes.
2. Weights; Weights may extend frontward no more than 24" in front of tractor casting and in back the weight can be any reasonable distance. All weights must be securely fastened, and not interfere with the hook up of tractor to sled.
3. **Drawbar Height - 20" for all classes, (rigid in all directions).**
4. Tires; 18.4 x 38 up to 8500, any size after 8500. **NO CUTS OF ANY KIND.**
5. **Stock core injection pumps in all classes, including Special classes.**
6. Pace; Paced classes will be paced at 4 MPH, 100' to set your speed, after cone horn blows you will be DQ'd.
7. **RPM's will be stock in Farm classes, 3000 in Special classes.** Will be checked with hand-held tach if in question.
8. No Nitrous, alcohol, or ether allowed, Stock fuel only.
9. Farm class tractors to have a working PTO and Hydraulics if equipped from factory.
10. **No water injection in Farm classes.**
11. Turbos - 2.0" Inducer Max. in 7500 Special class, 2.75" Inducer in all the other classes including heavier Specials. No reducer sleeves.
